**1-Booker T. Washington- (2-0)-(Beat Carol City-45-0)** Booker T. Washington has played three games if you include the kickoff classic vs. Norcross (GA). They have beaten each of their opponents by double digits including the third ranked team in Florida, Miami Central. Up next is another Dade County top team Miami Jackson. Booker T is not only the top rated team in Florida but also the nation as well.
